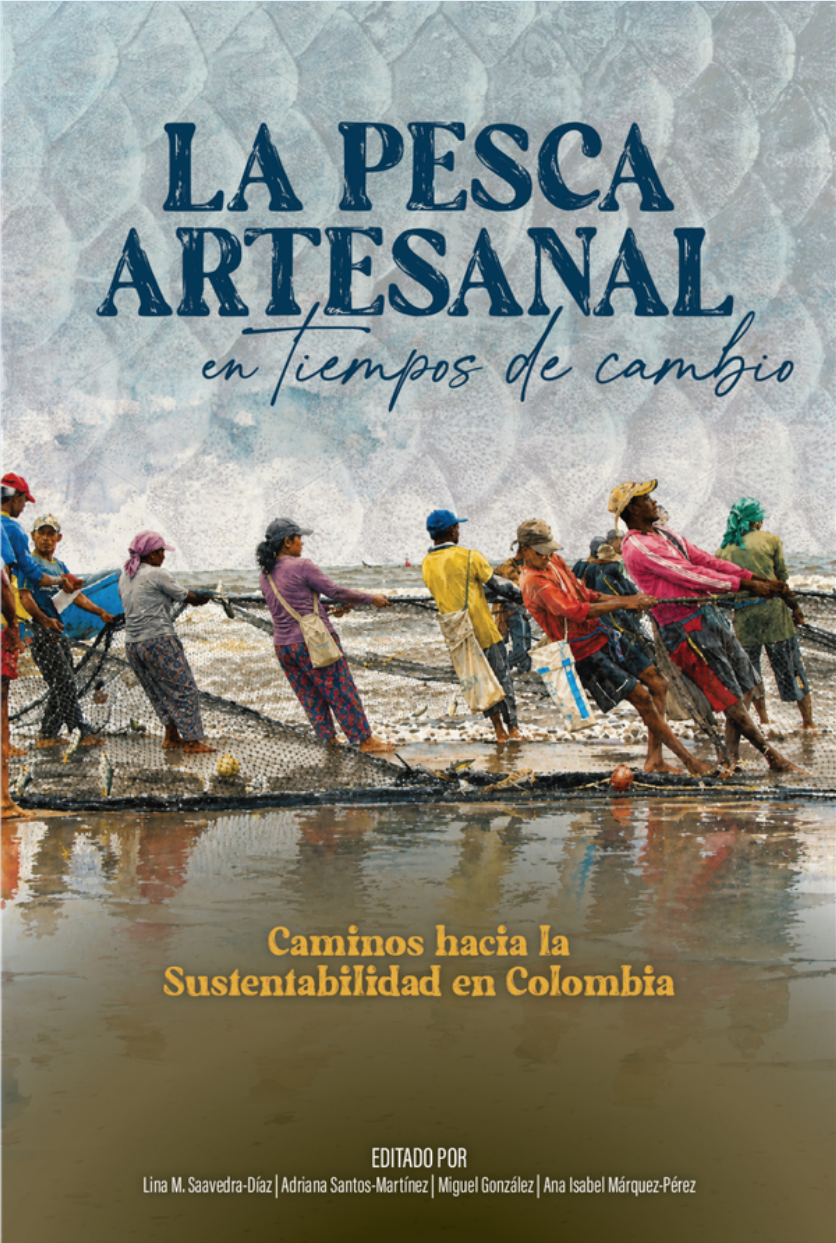

Through a dialogue of knowledge, spanning more than five decades of research, place-based experience, and policy implementation, the book examines the achievements, gaps, and challenges that shape the current landscape of artisanal fishing in the country. It explores themes ranging from livelihoods, traditions, governance, and the social organization of fishing communities, to the ecological and socioeconomic dynamics of fisheries, the roles of women and youth, and the multiple drivers of change that increasingly complicate SSF socio-ecological systems in the Anthropocene.

Why SSF & this book

- The review of governance and regulatory frameworks helps make visible how fisheries policy in Colombia are shaped, and enhances the recognition for transboundary management, and assessment of progress and gaps.

- Raise awareness about challenges and pressures facing SSF, coming from various sources like resource overexploitation, environmental degradation, conflict over access to resource and space, displacement and marginalization, and the erosion of traditional and local knowledge.

- By mapping what has been learned and what remains unaddressed, the book helps chart a course for evidence-based, inclusive policymaking and informs key directions for a forward-looking research agenda.

Pathways Toward SSF Sustainability

➤➤➤➤ Real-world case studies

Use management exercises and integrated models, balancing the ecological, social, economic and governance dimensions.

➤➤➤➤ Knowledge co-production

Examine how knowledge is co-produced, and engage stakeholders in synthesizing lessons and identifying gaps.

➤➤➤➤ Evidence-based planning

Share evidence and baseline with fishers, community members, and relevant stakeholders to better understand the current situation and co-develop feasible plans.

➤➤➤➤ Collective actions

Engage broadly and urgently with key stakeholders, to take concrete steps in helping SSF realize their contributions and potentials.
